The Hawaii Clean Energy Initiative (HCEI) establishes a plan for Hawaii to get 70 percent of its electricity and ground transportation from clean energy sources by 2030, the most aggressive goal in the nation and perhaps the world. As part of the HCEI, the Governor of Hawaii, the Hawaiian Electric companies, the State of Hawaii's Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism (DBEDT), and the State Consumer Advocate signed a groundbreaking energy agreement, with all parties agreeing on a plan for Hawaii's energy future. For both residential and consumer customers, changes will mean more choices and greater control over monthly electric bills. Increased energy prices, which are de-linked from oil prices, could make energy bills more stable and predictable. Ted Liu of DBEDT, Consumer Advocate Catherine Awakuni and Hawaiian Electric's Robbie Alm will discuss the most significant elements of this visionary plan and answer any questions.
