Transit Development Strategies & Pitfalls

Frank Villalobos, Barrio Planners Incorporated & Phillip Camp, NGA Hawaii LLP

Mr. Frank Villalobos of Barrio Planners Incorporated & Mr. Phillip J Camp of NGA Hawaii LLP, will discuss the design development strategies and pitfalls associated with transit oriented design, as well as mixed use development in general. In doing so, both will draw from past experience in previous mixed use projects as well as transit oriented design. Mr. Villalobos is currently spearheading the architectural oversight of the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension Transit project in Los Angeles, California. In many ways, the East LA effort is seen as a corollary to the proposed transit development currently being addressed in Honolulu. Mr. Villalobos' day to day involvement with the Eastside Extension Transit project which is currently under construction promises to bring to light many issues that can only be gleaned from hands on experience with transit development projects. In addition to current transit construction issues, Mr. Villalobos hopes to touch on development strategies that helped to win over the East LA community and created nodes of opportunity that the community has supported and encouraged during the construction process.
