Hawaii's Solar Market in Q1 2009: Opportunities and Constraints



Speaker

Mark Duda, Principal, Sunetric

Mark will discuss where the solar market is in Q1 2009 and where it may be headed for the remainder of the year given the various policy initiatives and marketplace developments that will influence the renewable energy sector in Hawaii over the coming months. The talk will also review issues around project finance and some business models that make solar energy work.

Mark Duda is a principal in Sunetric, formerly Suntech Hawaii, the state's largest locally owned and operated solar integrator. He leads the company's finance and accounting team, managing Sunetric's interactions with the energy finance industry. Mark is also President of the Hawaii Solar Energy Association (HSEA), a Member of the Hawaii Energy Policy Forum where he Co-Chairs the Renewables Working Group, a member of the Hawaii Clean Energy Initiative Energy Efficiency Working Group, and a Board Member of the Hawaii PV Coalition. In these roles he is a participant in legislative and regulatory efforts to expand the supply of renewable energy in Hawaii. Prior to joining Sunetric, Mark worked as a consultant specializing in housing and mortgage market issues, and as a Research Analyst at Harvard University's Joint Center for Housing Studies.
