In the next 20 years, Hawaii's population age 65 and older will nearly double. Are our communities designed to help these folks to "age in place" at home? It is important to note that 88% of local respondents to a recent AARP survey expressed their desire to age in place within their communities.

AARP Hawaii and PATH are launching a research project to find out if Hawaii is ready to meet the needs of this growing market segment, and to identify the kinds of support developers and landowners require to provide such communities.
